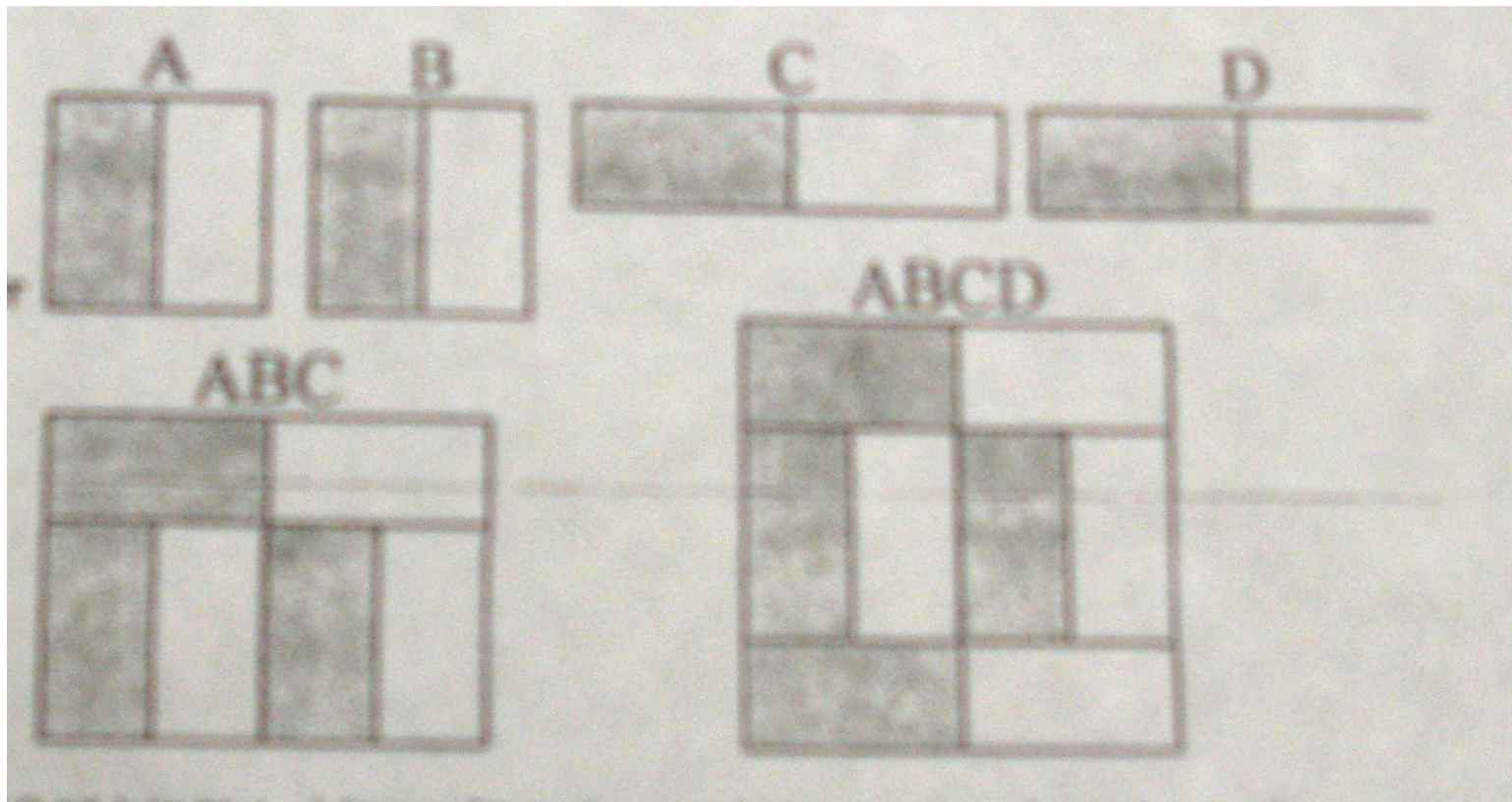


Blocks made for the **Batik** raffle basket for the Tri-Guild Lunch, put on by Moonlight Quilters of Sonoma County. **These blocks will ONLY be made by members of MQSC.**

If you can, please include enough fabric for another block, so that the winner of the raffle basket can make one for themselves.



### **Split Decision in Batik fabric**

Block size - 8 1/2" unfinished

Cutting directions for ONE block as follows:

**These strips should be in contrast to one another. The greater the contrast, the more distinct the block pattern will be.**

**Print A**

A. One strip 2 1/2" by 40"

**Print B**

B. One strip 2 1/2" by 40"

Sewing Instructions:

**Step 1.**

Take the dark strip and sew it to the light strip, using a scant 1/4" seam.

**Step 2. cut this strip into the following pieces:**

1. 2 each lengthwise cuts, 4 1/2" long, see A and B
2. 2 each crosswise cuts, 8 1/2" long, see C and D

**Step 3. sew as follows using a scant 1/4" seams:**

1. Sew long edges together of A and B, as shown in diagram as ABC
2. Sew joined A and B segments, to one "C" unit matching the diagram.
3. Sew sewn ABC to last unit shown as "D" matching the diagram.
4. This is the completed block.
