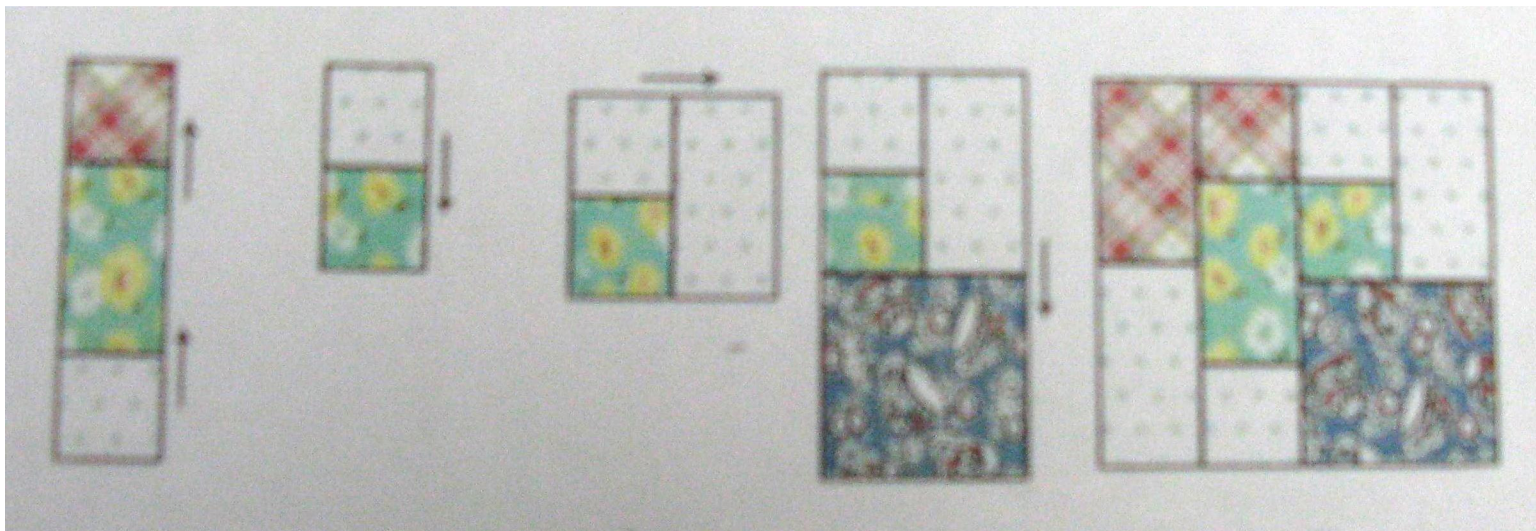


Blocks made for the **30's Prints and White** raffle basket for the Tri-Guild Lunch, put on by Moonlight Quilters of Sonoma County. These blocks will only be made by members of MQSC .

If you can, please include enough fabric for another block, so that the winner of the raffle basket can make one for themselves.



Hanky Panky in 30's Prints and WHITE (no cream or Muslin)

Block size - 10 1/2" unfinished

Cutting directions for ONE block as follows:

Light (either WHITE on white (**no cream**) or solid white (**no cream or muslin**):

A. 2 each squares: 3"

B. 2 each rectangles: 3" by 5 1/2"

Prints A and B

C. 2 each rectangles (1 from each print) 3" by 5 1/2"

D. 2 each squares (1 from each print) 3"

Print C

E. 1 square 5 1/2"

Step 1. (not shown in photo)

Sew 1 print rectangle and 1 white on white (or solid white) rectangle together on the short edges. Press toward the print rectangle.

Step 2 (first piece on left)

Sew a white on white square, a second print rectangle and a print **square** matching the rectangle in step one. Press as shown (towards the print fabrics).

Step 3

Sew a print square that matches the rectangle in Step 2 to a white on white square. Press toward the print square.

Sew this unit to the top of a white on white rectangle. Press toward the rectangle.

Step 4

Sew a Step 3 unit to the right side of the large print square.

Press toward the rectangle.

Step 5

Sew a Step 1 Step 2 and a Step 4 unit together to make a block. Press the seams lightly, as you may want to press the seams to alternate when you put the blocks together.

Repeat to make a total of 9, 20, 48, 72 or 90 blocks.
