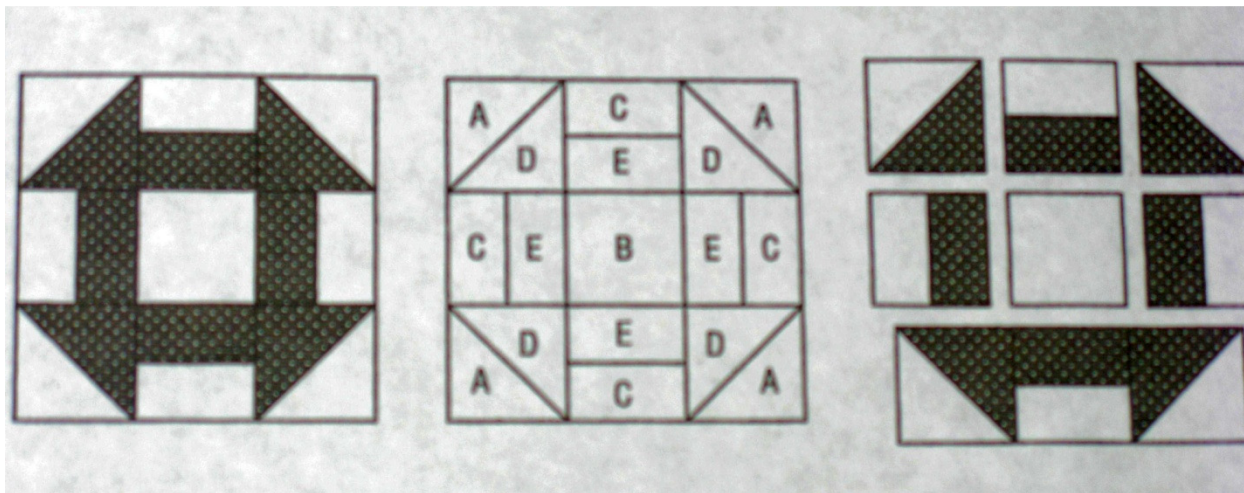


Blocks made for the **Black and White** raffle basket for the Tri-Guild Lunch, put on by Moonlight Quilters of Sonoma County. These blocks will only be made by members of MQSC .

If you can, please include enough fabric for another block, so that the winner of the raffle basket can make one for themselves.



Churn Dash in Black and White (NO cream)

The more variety of black with white and white with black fabrics will make this raffle basket more interesting.

Block size - 12 1/2" unfinished

Cutting directions for ONE block as follows:

Light (either WHITE on white (**no cream**) or solid white (**no cream**):

- A. 2 each 4 7/8" squares cut ONCE diagonally
- B. 1 each 4 1/2" square
- C. 4 rectangles 2 1/2" by 4 1/2"

Black (white on black or black on white)

- D. 2 each 4 7/8" squares cut ONCE diagonally
- E. 4 each 2 1/2" by 4 1/2"

Right sides together:

1. One each of A and B triangles - stitch on diagonal using a scant 1/4" seam - press toward dark. Repeat four times for a total of four sets of half square triangles.
2. One each of C and E - stitch on the long side, press toward dark. You will have four sets.
3. Look at photograph for placements of components when sewing block together.
