
General 'rule' to yield 4 FLYING GEESE is,

Goose fabric: Cut one square the finished length of the base side, plus 1 1/4 inches

Sky fabric: Cut four squares the finished height plus 7/8 inch. Mark diagonals

With right sides together, lay two smaller squares over opposite diagonal corners of the larger square and sew scant 1/4 inch on both sides of the diagonal lines.



Cut apart on the diagonal, press the triangles back.



Lay the last two smaller squares over the remaining corners and sew scant 1/4 inch on both sides of the diagonal.
