

Moonlight Quilters – Due August 21

Glass Jar

8.5" Unfinished

Fabric required:

Jar - One piece of a novelty fabric with bugs or fish or whatever you would like in your jar, 5.5 x 6.5.

Lid - Cut one piece for the jar lid, black, gray or a color or pattern to go with the novelty fabric, 1.5 x 3.5 inches.

Background fabric: if you cut a 8.25 x 7 inch piece, all the background can be cut from that.

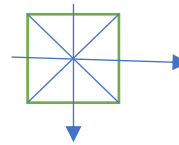
Cutting diagram for background pieces:

Cut one strip 3 inches wide by 8.25 inches, then sub-cut two pieces 2.5 inches x 3, and one 3 inch square. Discard the remainder of the strip.

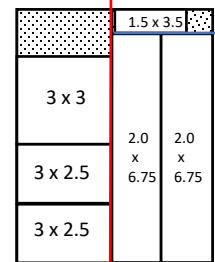
Cut the remaining 4 inch strip by 6.75 inches then cut that into two strips of 2 inch by 6.75 inches.

From the remaining piece cut 1.5 x 3.5 inch piece.

On the 3 x 3 background square draw a diagonal line in both directions. Cut this into 1.5 inch squares.

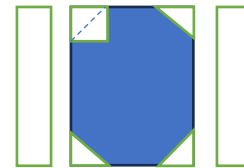


Cut 3-inch strip



Piecing:

Attach one 1.5 inch square at each corner of the jar fabric. Snowball the corners by sewing on the line and folding it back. Press and cut away the back layers.



Attach the two 2 inch strips to each of the long sides of the jar.

Sew the Lid fabric to the 1.5 x 3.5 inch background piece, press.

The last two pieces go on either side of the lid.

The short sides are sewn to the lid.



Sew the lid section to the jar. You can fold each in half and cress to find the middle and match the middle of the top of the jar to the middle of the lid. (See the short dark line)
