The 411 on Medallions and Panels

In addition to the medallion starts we normally have, the medallion program has a new twist this year - panels! There are four panels available this year that will be given to community quilts when they are done. There are three spots to sign up for - top creation, quilting, and binding. Each panel has some starting fabric. Just like medallions, additional fabric will be needed to complete the top. Batting and backing for quilting can be donated or obtained from the Community Quilt

program. Deadlines for these three steps will follow the medallion schedule. Sign-ups for medallions and the panels will take place at the business meeting on October 4th. They will be available to preview at MQSC.org sometime after 9/30. * If you are unable to attend in person, please have a friend sign up for you. We will take sign up requests after the meeting through email requests taken in the order they were received. Please indicate the medallion number and/or name and which round you want to sign up for. 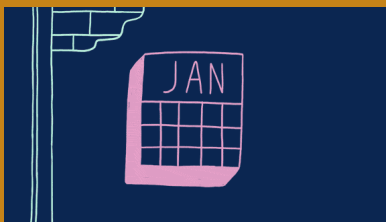

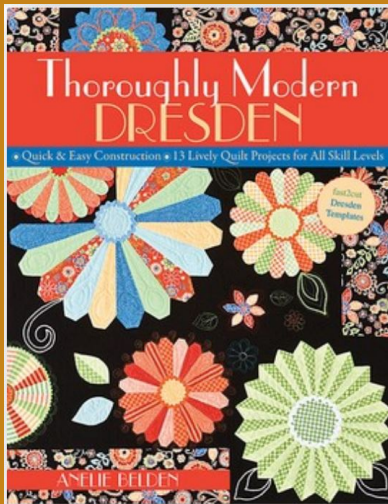
Falling Leave Quilt Show October 7 & 8 and PIQF October 12-15 2023 AND MQSC at Rincon Valley Library
