

Moonlight Quilters – Due February 1

Playful Monkey Wrench

12 ½ Unfinished

Fabrics Needed:

Children's themed feature fabric

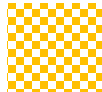
Solid fabric in a color to complement the feature fabric

Background fabric – white or white on white



Cut Feature Fabric:

1 4 ½ x 4 ½ inches square



Cut Other pieces:

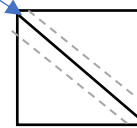
2 5 x 5 inches of solid color fabric

2 5 x 5 inches of background fabric, draw a diagonal line on the back of each

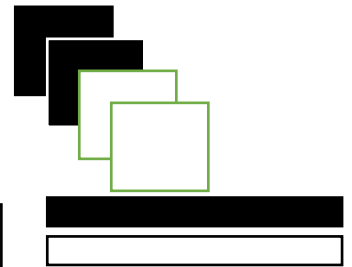
1 2 ½ x 19 inches of solid color fabric

1 2 ½ x 19 inches of background fabric

Draw a line



Sewing line



Step one: make half square triangle.

Take one each of the solid color and a background 5-inch squares.

Right sides together and sew a scant ¼ inch (a tiny bit closer to the drawn line) on both sides of the drawn line and cut on the line.

Press to the dark side. Repeat with the other two squares.

Trim all blocks to 4 ½ inches square.



Step two: make the straight pieces.

Take the 2 ½ strips, right sides together and sew them together along the long side, using a scant ¼ inch seam (a tiny bit closer to the outside edge). Press to the dark side.

Cut four pieces from this strip, trim to 4 ½ inch squares.

Cut 4 ½ squares



Step three: assemble rows.

Row 1 Layout all the 4 ½ inch blocks in rows.

Attach the blocks as shown, use a ¼ inch seams.

Half square triangle to straight piece,

then the last half square triangle to the other side of the straight piece.

Press the seams toward the center

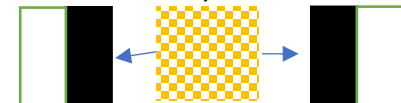
Press to center



Row 2 Straight piece to the feature square, then another straight piece.

Press the seams away from the center.

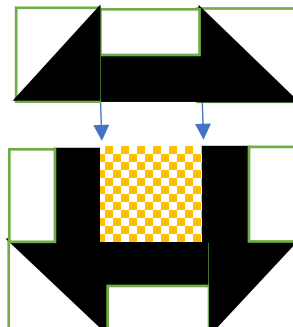
Press away from center



Row 3 Is the same as Row 1.

Step Four: Sew the rows together.

Attach each row, matching the seams at the blocks.



Press and trim to 12 ½ inches.
