

## Supply List for PAPER PIECING Basic Skills

Saturday August 24, 2024  
SR Vet's North Room - 10am-3pm

Looking forward to sharing paper piecing with you at our next basic skills class. I will have the room ready for you to come early to set up at 9:45am. We will be making 3 or 4 sample blocks and the following supplies will help you enjoy the day!

SEWING MACHINE: Clean with a new #14 or 12 needle. Able to stitch 18-20 stitches per inch or a setting of 1.5

Foot pedal and cords

Power strip if you have one; a light

ROTARY CUTTER and MAT, RULERS with a good 1/4" line - you will be doing this next to your machine as you sew so smaller sizes will work. Longest ruler needed is 12". A fresh blade is good!

SCISSORS for both fabric and paper

THREAD a midtone neutral cotton

ANY OTHER basic sewing supplies: Pins (thin), seam ripper, etc.

PRESSING: Please no personal irons - power in the room is not great. You may use a hand roller or a slanted stick or your fingers. There will only be a couple of ironing stations.

FABRICS: We will be making blocks of different sizes so a variety of sizes of cotton fabrics from scraps up to fat quarters in colors of your choice will give you options. Just try to have light, medium and dark values.

COMFORTS; Water, lunch, pillows for chairs, pencil or pen for notes, a fan?
