

Holiday Cabin



Instructions: This 12 1/2" block can be made from light and dark Holiday scraps and should measure 12 1/2" when you have completed construction of the block.

Please consistently use a red square for the center (one is available for use) and for the light sides choose a holiday print in whites or light cream/tans, for the opposite sides please select from your red and green holiday scraps. This block does not take very much fabric and the wider the variety of holiday prints the more fun the quilt blocks will be. The table below will assist you in placing your logs in the right order if you don't have a color copy of the block.

Helpful hints!! Please use an accurate 1/4" seam allowance or better yet a scant 1/4" seam allowance. For my sample I squared up the block after each round of 4 logs in order to achieve the block in the correct size. It is very easy to keep your piece in check...once you have completed the first row of cabin logs...square it up. The first square should measure 6 1/2", the second round will measure out at 9 1/2" and the last will measure at 12 1/2". These steps make for a nice straight and square block.

Sewing Order:			
Piece	Fabric Color	Cut Size	Sewing position
Center Square	Red	3 1/2"	Center
Log #1	Neutral	2" x 3 1/2"	top
Log #2	Neutral	2"x 5"	left
Log #3	Green	2"x 5"	bottom
Log #4	Red	2" x 6 1/2"	right
Log #5	Neutral	2"x 6 1/2"	top
Log #6	Neutral	2"x 8"	left
Log #7	Green	2"x 8"	bottom
Log #8	Red	2"x 9 1/2"	right
Log #9	Neutral	2 x 9 1/2"	top
Log #10	Neutral	2"x 11"	left
Log #11	Green	2"x 11"	bottom
Last Log #12	Red	2"x 12 1/2"	right
