KIMONO

Fabrics:

Off white background
Asian fabric



Cutting:

From the Background fabric

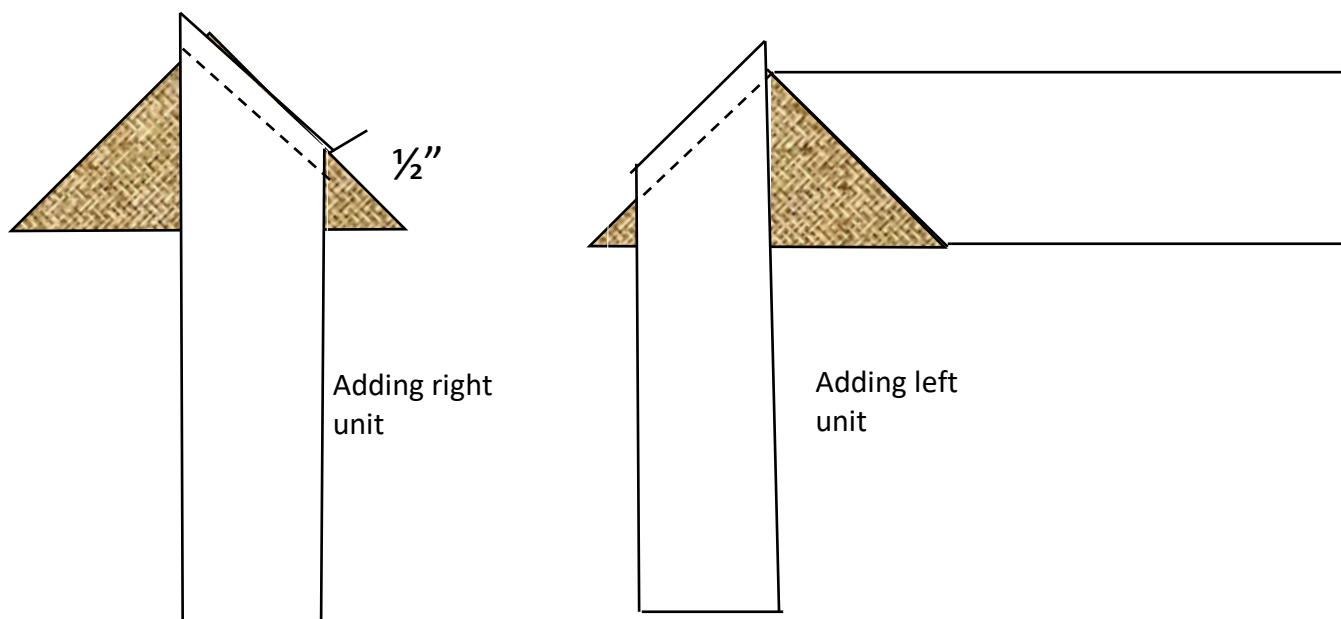
- Cut 2 – 3 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangles
- Cut 2 – 1 1/2" X 6 1/4" rectangles. Cut the ends off at a 45-degree angle. You need the 2 pieces to be mirror images, so cut 2 pieces of fabric wrong sides together.

From the Asian fabric:

- Cut 1 – 2 1/2" square and cut it diagonally. Use one triangle for the collar.
- Cut 1 – 5 1/2" X 11 1/2" rectangle (body)
- Cut 2 – 3 1/2" X 5 1/2" rectangles (sleeves)

Piecing:

1. Sew the sleeves to the 3 1/2" X 6 1/2" background, sleeve on top.
2. Sew the sleeve units to both sides of the kimono body.
3. Sew the background strips with the angle to the triangle as shown below.
4. Trim the "ears" above the collar.
5. Sew the collar unit to the top of the kimono.
