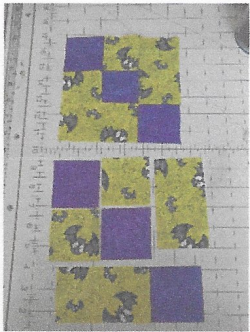


Block of the Month....

Halloween Crosses

This is a very quick and fun block to assemble from your stash. You will only use 2 1/2" strips and I just pulled from my Halloween fabric scraps...nothing fancy...just have fun...they will all look great together if you are the lucky winner.

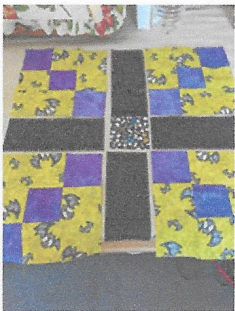
Start with making 4 nine patch blocks. I made mine starting with a 4 patch in the corner and then added a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" bar at the end. For the bottom of the 9 patch I added the 3rd diagonal square to another 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" bar....easy peasy...but if you like you can make all 2 1/2" squares and sew them together...it's all up to you.



- Ⓐ [BACKGROUND (8) 2 1/2" squares
- " " " (8) 2 1/2 x 4 1/2" rectangles
- Ⓑ - Diagonals (12) 2 1/2" squares
- Ⓒ - BARS (4) 2 1/2 x 6 1/2" rectangles
- Ⓓ - CENTER SQ (1) 2 1/2"

FINISHED AT 6 1/2" square

Once you've made your 4 9-Patch blocks with the diagonal blocks...you will add a 6 1/2" bar between the 9-Patches....with a center 2 1/2" center square. You can fussy cut the center or use whatever pleases your eye.



finished block is 14 1/2" square

The finished block will be 14 1/2".....let the Halloween spirit guide you.

Choose any fabrics you like...any background you have...just have fun!!
