

Moonlight Quilters – Due November 2

Autumn Cabin Block

8 ½ Unfinished

Fabrics Needed:

4 Autumn Colors in Batiks (golden yellow, orange, brown, rust, dark green)

You choose which colors to use in each step

1 Black



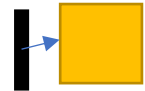
Cut the following pieces:

- A 1 3 ½ square of one of the Batiks
- B 1 1 inch x 7 ½ inch strip Black, from this cut 3 ½ inch piece
- C 1 2 inch strip x 9 ½ inches, from this cut 4 inches
- D 1 2 inch strip x 12 ½ inches, from this cut 5 ½ inches
- E 1 2 ½ inch strip x 16 inches, from this cut 7 inches

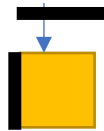


Border the Center Square

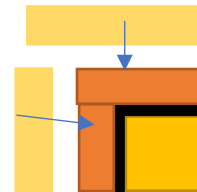
Sew the black 1 x 3 ½ strip to left side of the side of the “A” square. Press the seam toward the square. Attach the remaining black piece (1 x 4) to the top of the square. Press away from the square.



Next attach Fabric C, the 2 x 4 inch strip to the left side. Pressing towards the square. Attach the remaining 2 x 5 ½ piece to the top and press away.

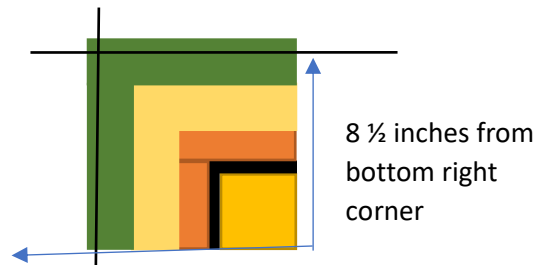


Attach Fabric D in the same way as Fabric C. Sewing the short piece to the left side and the longer piece to the top. Continue to press the seams as directed.



Attach Fabric E in the same way. This strip is a little wider than the previous two so that you can trim the block to 8 ½ inches.

Using a square ruler will help with this step. Align the ruler at the bottom right with the 8 ½ inch marks on the right and bottom. Trim along the top and left of the block.



8 ½ inches from bottom right corner towards the left.
