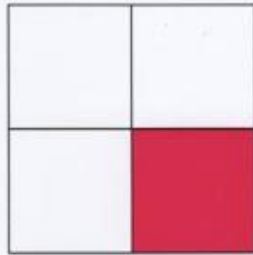


Circle of Squares

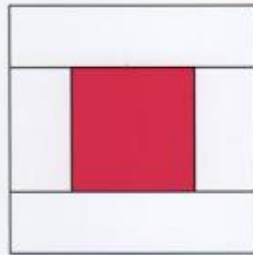


We have another great block this month. With permission from Janeth at tofeather.blogspot.com, we're going to make this block using warm colors (ie. red, orange, yellow, pink) for the eight squares and cream for the background. The more fabrics you use, the better. Janeth's instructions were so good, we decided to go with her instructions for the block.

You will need four units like this which are made up of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Once the squares are sewn together, the unit measures $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



You will need four units like this which are made up of one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square bordered by $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips on all sides. This unit will also measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

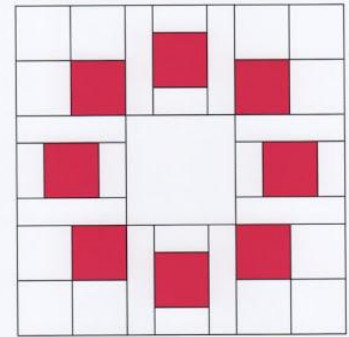


You will need one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square for the center.



Now you have nine $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Sew the units together as a nine patch.



Two strips are $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " and two are $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "
