# Moonlight Quilters - Due February 7 <br> Thread Spool 

6.5" Unfinished

This is a very old basic block. It goes together very quickly.
$13.5 \times 3.5$ inch
$22 \times 3.5$ inch
$22 \times 6.5$ inch
$42 \times 2$ inch sq. Background, muslin or very light cream
Stripe fabric, any color, narrow stripes are best Background, muslin or very light cream Wooden spool, brown, print or solid


## Wooden spool

Draw a line diagonally on the back of all four muslin squares.
Place them on the wooden spool fabric pieces with the diagonal lines, towards the center.
Sew along the line, next to the pencil line, a little on the outside,
 (away from the center).
Fold back towards the outside and press to the outside. Trim off excess.


## Thread center

Take the two muslin background pieces and place on either side of the stripe fabric making sure that the stripes are running horizontal (towards the seam)
Attach the background pieces and press to the center.


## Assemble

Take each of the three pieces and lay them out to orient the top and bottom Wooden spool pieces so that the diagonal pieces point to the center Both top and bottom.
