

MQSC Block of the Month

Due: September 2, 2015

Finished Size: 15"



Children's Delight

September's block is quick and easy. You will need two fabrics. The background is black (solid or tonal). For the focus fabric we are asking you to use a cool color (blue, green, purple). The block is fat quarter and stash friendly, but you may need to adjust your cutting measurements.

Cutting Instructions:

Black Background:

One 6 1/2" square

One 3 1/2" x 39" strip

Cut strip into Five 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles and Two 3 1/2" squares.

Focus Fabric:

One 3 1/2" x 29 1/2" strip

Cut strip into Four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles and One 3 1/2" square.

Assembling the Block:

We suggest, that you first lay the pieces out according to the photo below. Starting with the top row, join the pieces together to make each row. Then join the rows to complete the block. Be sure to press to the black background fabric. "Square up" your block to 15 1/2".
