



Finished block size: 8" x 13.5" (unfinished is 8.5" x 14")

Variations on this block have been featured by a number of quilt designers over the years but this one, called Bliss on their website, comes from the Moda Bake Shop. It would look great in a wide variety of fabrics: batiks, Asian, 30's, Civil War, etc, but we've chosen a Halloween theme. This one has a complex look while being easy to sew. Make one block or make several, and you'll receive one ticket for each block turned in. Have fun!

Fabric

- (2) coordinating Halloween prints (or fabrics in Halloween colors) at least 4.5" wide x 10" high
- (4) Scraps of cream tone-on-tone
- (4) Scraps of black tone-on-tone

Cut

- Cut (2) 4.5" x 10" rectangles from the Halloween prints
- Cut (4) 2.5" x 2.5" squares of the light fabric
- Cut (4) 2.5" x 2.5" squares of the black fabric

Sew

1. Using scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams, and the illustration below as your guide, create (2) 4-patch units using the 2.5" x 2.5" light and black fabrics, and press.



2. To create the half-blocks, sew a 4-patch unit to a 4.5" x 10" rectangle, positioning the 4-patch in the directions shown below, and press toward the rectangle. Pay close attention to the direction of the Halloween prints.



3. Position the two 4-patch and rectangle units side-by-side as shown above, so that on the left side, the 4-patch is at the top, and on the right side, it is at the bottom. Sew the two together, and press.
