

Finished block size: 12" (unfinished is 12.5")

The Oklahoma Twister block is brought to you via The Quilter's Cache and makes up beautifully in the bright batiks on a black background. The triangles form a twisting pattern with a lot of inherent motion. You'll receive one ticket for each block turned in. Have fun!

Fabric

- 1 fat quarter each of a medium bright batik and a solid black. A standard quarter will also work.

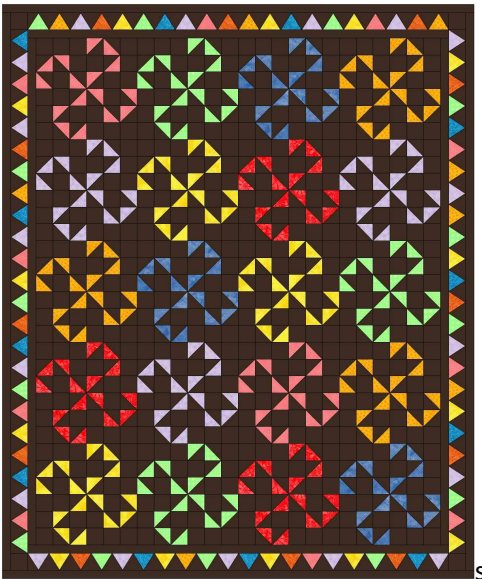
Cut

- Cut (8) 2 7/8" black squares and (8) 2 7/8" colored squares.
- Cut (20) 2 1/2" black squares.

Sew

- Using your favorite method, create 16 half-square triangles from the 2-7/8" black and colored squares.
- Using the illustration above as your guide, assemble the block, row by row.
