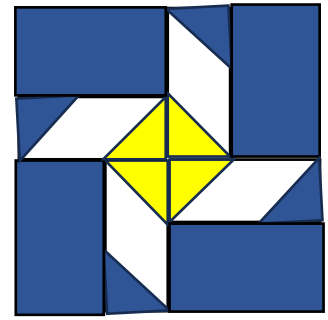


Moonlight Quilters – Due February 4

10.5" Unfinished

This is a simple pinwheel style block. You can use solids or small prints as long as they are mostly the color we are looking for (mostly white, mostly yellow, mostly navy).



White

4 2.5 inch x 5.5 inch rectangle

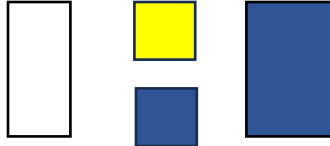
Yellow

4 2.5 inch squares

Navy Blue

4 2.5 inch squares

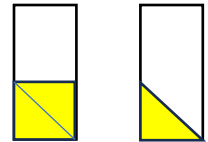
4 3.5 inch x 5.5 inch rectangle



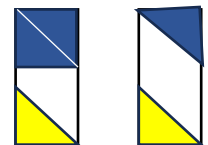
Starting with the white piece, place the yellow square at the bottom edge.

Sew diagonally from the upper left side to the lower right side, as shown.

Trim excess away and press away from the white fabric. Repeat with other three white rectangles.



Next place the 2.5 inch navy square on the other end of the each of the white and yellow rectangles. Sew on the diagonal from the upper left to the lower right, the same direction as the yellow patch's seam. Trim excess and press away from the white.



Place the navy rectangle to the white/yellow/navy rectangle making sure to attach it to the side with the Navy fabric triangle will touch the navy rectangle. Press to the dark side.



Take all four units and place them with the yellow triangle in the center, rotating them as shown. The yellow triangle seams should match up. Sew together as a four patch.
