## Fun Fast House

## 10.5" Unfinished

A quick house block. You need 2.5 inch strips for half the block.

| 1 | $2.5 \times 3.5$ | Door, any color |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| 1 | $2.5 \times 13.5$ | House, any color. Cut this strip into 3 pieces: 3.5 inch, 4.5 inch and 5.5 inch. |
| 1 | $2.5 \times 11$ | Background, white or light sky blue, cut into Two 5.5 inch pieces. |
| 1 | $4.5 \times 8.5$ | Roof, any color. |
| 1 | $5.5 \times 5.5$ sq. | Background fabric |
| 1 | $5.5 \times 6.5$ | Background fabric |

Building the house
Starting with the door, add the 3.5 inch house fabric to the long side (1 to 2 ).
Next add the 4.5 inch piece across the top (3)
Last add the 5.5 inch strip to the other side of the door's long side(4).
Attach the two 5.5 inch background pieces to each side ( 5 and 6 ).


Always press the seams away from the door.

## Making the Roof and Sky

Take the roof fabric and place the $5.5 \times 5.5$ square to the top right of the roof, lining up the edges on the top and the right. At the top edge measure over 4.5 inches from the right corner and make a mark. From the right side corner measure down 4.5 inches and make another mark. Draw a line between the two marks. Sew a little on the outside next to this line. Trim off the right corner and press seam towards the roof.


Take the $5.5 \times 6.5$ inch background piece and place it on the left side of the roof fabric. Line up the top of this piece with the background piece that was just attached and the left side of the roof fabric the background will be longer than the roof. Make marks 5.5 inches from the left corner at the top and side as shown. Draw a line between the two marks. Sew a little on the outside next to this line. Trim off the right
 corner and press seam away from the roof.

Sew the two halves together, roof to house. Press towards the roof. This should measure 10.5 inches square.
