Craft time 30 minutes

Cut your Fabrics:

4 Assorted light or medium 5 ½" X 5 ½" squares for snowballs

Background: Winter blue 12- 2" squares and 4 2 ½" X 5 ½" rectangles

Jewel Tone for center star 4- 2" squares and 1 - 2 ½" square



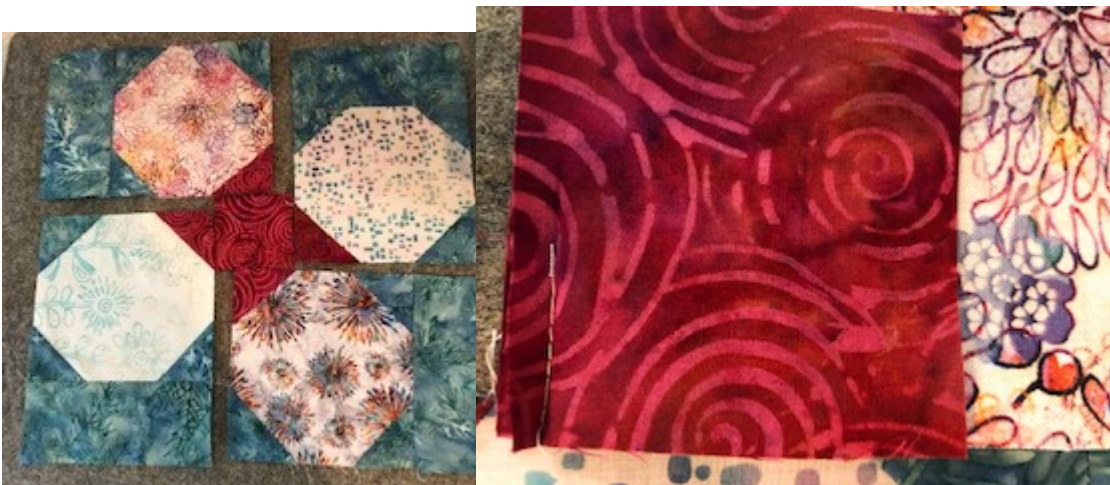
Make snowballs with one jewel tone square and 3 background squares. Use flip and stitch method. If needed: <https://quiltnotes.com/learning-center/stitch-and-flip/>

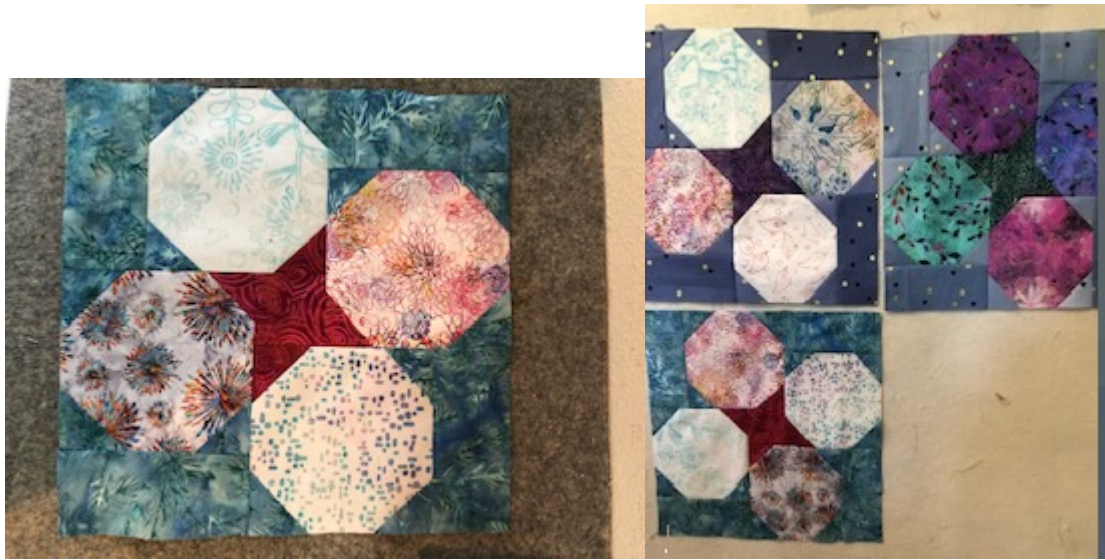
Arrange layout of square and Sew on 2 ½X 5 ½ strips



Sew partial seam for the star 2 ½' square to upper left snowball



Attach upper right section to upper left section. Attach lower right section to block. Attach lower left section inner right seam to block. Finish final seam with partial stitching.
