

# Moonlight Quilters – Due March 1

## Sawtooth Star

8 ½ Unfinished

### Fabrics Needed:

White on White, 2 ½ strip x 20 inches

Red, 2 ½ strip x 28 inches

Black and White, 4 ½ x 4 ½ square

### Cut White on White:

8 2 ½ x 2 ½ inches squares

### Cut Red Fabric:

4 4 ½ x 2 ½ rectangles

4 2 ½ x 2 ½ inch squares



### Step one: Make the star points which are 4 Flying Geese blocks.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the white on white squares.

Place one white square on one side of each red rectangle piece.

Sew on the line, fold the white square in half along the stitching.

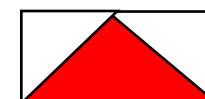
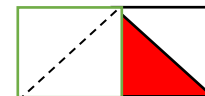
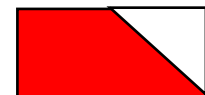
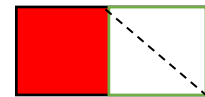
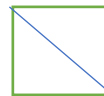
Press away from center, trim off excess fabric leaving ¼ inch seam allowance.

Place one white square on the opposite side of each red rectangle,

Sew on the line and fold up as before. Press away from center and trim

excess fabric on the back leaving a ¼ inch seam allowance.

Draw a line



Flying Geese Block

### Step two: Layout the pieces

Row 1 and 3

Attach one red square to each side on two of the Flying Geese blocks. Press away from center.

Row 2

Attach a Flying Geese block

To each side of the black and white center square.

Press to the center.

### Step 3: Attach the rows

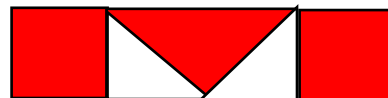
Attach Row 1 to Row 2.

Attach Row 3 to Row 2.

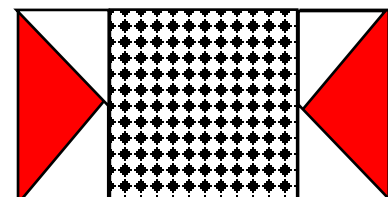
Press these two new seams open.

The block should measure 8 ½ inches square.

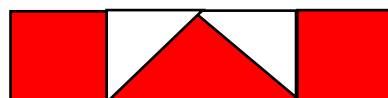
