May 01,2023 (Via Zoom)

### **President Denise Ragozzino called the meeting to order at 7:00pm**

Denise moved the minutes from the 3/6/2023 Board Meeting be approved, Miriam Marlin seconded the motion, all agreed.

An earlier meeting time was discussed, it was agreed the subject be revisited at a later date.

Denise has found the keys to the file cabinet in storage.

Karen Derrick raised the subject of increasing the E-Blast potential on Mail Chimp, after some discussion it was motioned by Kathy Vedder and seconded by Gina Stateler-Calhoun to purchase the increased potential for \$156 a year.

### **Vice President's Report – Kathy Vedder**

Kathy made mention of the need to purchase electrical cables of our own for future events, was agreed the matter would be referred to the budget committee for review.

# Patchwords

**Membership in MQSC** is open to all who share an interest in quilting. Members enjoy meetings and special events, receive a monthly newsletter, have use of a library of quilting books, videos, and patterns, and receive discounts from some affiliate members.

**Dues** are \$45 annually, \$15 for those younger than 16 who are accompanied by an adult member, \$50 for affiliates.
