



Finished block size: 12" (unfinished is 12.5")

Here's a simple block that will showcase some of those beautiful metallic Asian fabrics we all love. It's easy to sew and only takes 1/8 yard of two fabrics. The assembled quilt forms a stairway design in a scrappy colorway. Make one or make several! You'll receive one ticket for each block turned in. Have fun!

Fabric

- Approximately 1/8 yard (or a fat eighth) of two prints: one off-white or cream (think neutral), and one Asian print in a color of your choice. We recommend avoiding very directional fabrics. :-)

Cut

- (4) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips of each color.

Sew

1. Using 1/4" seams, and the illustration above as your guide, sew two dark rectangles together to make a center square.
2. Add a light rectangle to the top and the bottom of the square, and press toward the darker fabric.
3. Sew the ends of a light and dark rectangle together, press, and add to the left side as shown.
4. Repeat step 3 for the right side.
