

BLOCK OF THE MONTH -- February, 2019

Cupid hits the spot! Unfinished block is 9 1/2"

Color A is the background and center square

Color B is the Theme fabric

Cutting Instructions:

Color A Cut 1 3 1/2" square



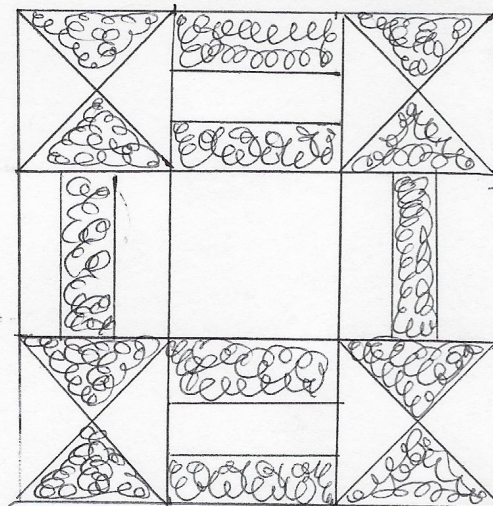
Cut 2 4 1/4" squares for 1/4 square triangle blocks

Cut 1 3 1/2' x 9" strip of Color A and sub-cut into 6 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" logs

Color B Cut 2 4 1/4" squares for 1/4 square triangle blocks

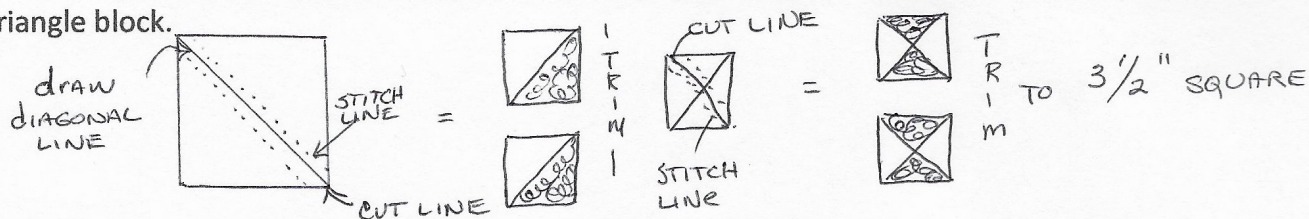


Cut 1 3 1/2" x 9" strip of Color B and sub-cut into 6 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" logs



Assembly instructions:

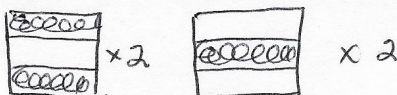
Draw a diagonal line on the back of the two Color A 4 1/4" blocks and place one on top of a Color B block. Sew a scant 1/4" to each side of the diagonal line for each block. Cut on the drawn line and press to the dark fabric. Trim the little "dog" ears on each of the now created 1/2 square triangle block.



Layer one 1/2 square triangle block on top of the other, offsetting the colors. Mark another diagonal line and sew a scant 1/4" on either side of the diagonal line. Cut on the diagonal line and press open. Trim the completed 1/4 square triangle block to 3 1/2" square.

HINT! Test to make sure that your seams nestle together this should help in having your points match on the completed 1/4 square triangle block.

From the logs assemble 4 blocks following the diagram above. Trim the blocks to 3 1/2".



Sew the block together in rows working to match your corner points... see diagram above and you have completed Cupid Hits the Spot!
