

Moonlight Quilters – Due October 4

Simple Flower

6.5" Unfinished

Flowers can be any color, make the background white and the centers black.
Note: measurements will be shown as this: 2.5 instead of 2 ½ and 2.75 instead of 2 ¾ for example.

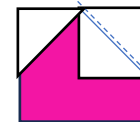
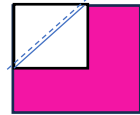
- 4 3.5 inch squares for the petals
- 8 2.0 inch squares for background
- 4 1.5 inch squares for the black centers



Make Petals

On each of the 4 petals attach a white background piece. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each of the white squares and stitch to the outside next to the line. Press toward the outside along the stitching. Trim off the two layers under the triangle. Next attach another white square to the right of the first one in the same way. Press to the outside and trim off excess fabric on the back.

Last attach the black center fabric to the right of the previous white piece. Press and trim all 4 petal pieces to 3.5 inches.



Assemble the four patch

Sew two petal pieces together with the black touching.
Repeat with the last two petals.
Press and join the two new pieces together matching the seams in the center to make a flower.
Press and trim to 6.5 inches.
