


Moonlight Quilters — Due March 4, 2026

Happy Homes

12.5" Unfinished

Make three different townhouses with the same sky and window sill fabrics, above a sidewalk-gray or grass-green strip. You are encouraged to fussy cut at least one window fabric to indicate a happy home.

Qty.	Width x Height (inches)	Placement
1	12.5 x 1.75	Cement or grass (A)
2 each of 3	1.5 x 8.25	House sides (B)
1 each of 3	2.5 x 2	House fronts, above door (C)
3	2.5 x 1	Window sill (D), common to all three houses
1 each of 3	2.5 x 4	Doors (E)
1 each of 3	2.5 x 2.75	Windows (F)
1 each of 3	4.5 x 3.5	Roofs (G)
6	2.5 x 2.5	Sky (H), common to all three houses



1. Sew house front (C) to top of house door (E). Sew window (F) to top of sill (D). Then sew the window unit to the door unit. Make sure these three center units are 2.5 x 8.25 inches.
2. Sew the house sides (B) to each side of the corresponding center units.
3. Draw a diagonal line on the six sky squares (H). Sew them to the upper edge of the three roofs (G) using the stitch and flip method. Trim the excess to 1/4-inch. Note: If you press the middle roof's sky seam *up*, and the first and third roofs' sky seam *down*, they will nest nicely in Step 5.
4. Sew the roof/sky units to the houses. Press the middle house/roof seam *down* and press the first and third roof/house seam *up*, to nest.
5. Sew the houses together, aligning seams.
6. Finally, sew the gray or green strip (A) to the bottom. The block should measure 12.5" square.
