Fabric Show Scraps



Bring your scraps and raise guild funds (while reducing landfill impact). We're looking for pre-sorted bundles of:

Cottons

- coordinated sets of fabrics (orphan blocks, off cuts and scraps from individual projects). place folded fabric in bags.
- pieces smaller than a fat quarter (if there are multiple bits of the same fabric, please safety pin together)
- square shapes (2" or larger)
- triangle shapes (any size)
- strings (strips 6" - 42" in length between 1" - 6" wide)
