

Halloween Block

Finished Size 18 1/2

Fabric Needed:

- 4 Fat quarters of different Halloween fabrics
- 1 Fat quarter of black or grey fabric

abbreviations:

- H = means Halloween fabric
- B or G = Black or Grey fabric

Cutting Instructions:

- Cut 1- 3 1/2" square from each Halloween fabric.
- Cut 1- 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" from each Halloween fabric.
- Cut 1- 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" from each Halloween fabric.

- Cut 4 - 3 1/2 " square from Black or Grey fabric
- Cut 4 - 3 1/2 "x 6 1/2" from Black or Grey fabric

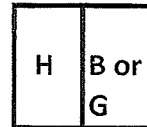
1. Sew one 3 1/2" square Halloween fabric to one of the black or grey fabrics.
This makes a total of 4 different blocks
Press seams open.

Unit 1:



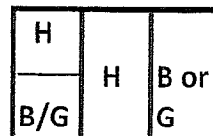
2. Sew one 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" of Halloween fabric to one of the black or grey fabrics.
This makes a total of 4 different blocks
Press seams open.

Unit 2:



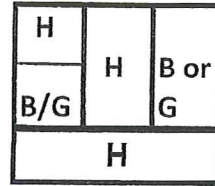
3. Sew Unit 1 to Unit 2 as shown, which will create unit 3.
Make 4 .
Press seams open.

Unit 3:



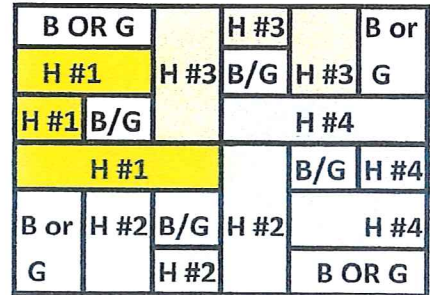
4. Layout one 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" Halloween piece to the above unit 3 on the side, see diagram. Layout all pieces as shown in Unit 5.

5. Sew them together and you will see the "J" pattern as shown in diagram. Press seams open
