

Moonlight Quilters of Sonoma County
June Block of the Month
Hunter Star
Unfinished Block is 12 1/2" square

Cutting Instruction for Background fabric

(mine is Cream with White stars on it)

Colors could be Cream, white or white on white

4 squares , 3 1/2" by 3 1/2"

4 squares , 4" by 4"

Red fabric

2 squares, 4" by 4"

Blue fabric

2 squares, 4" by 4"

Red and Blue Star fabric

4 square, 4" by 4"

Start with taking 2 of the 4" squares of the background fabrics and 2 of the 4" squares Star fabric and place right side together. Create a half square triangle. Press seam open and trim to 3 1/2" square. You will have 4 - 3 1/2" squares.

Make an other set of HST by taking 2 of the 4" squares of the background fabrics and 1 Red fabric and 1 blue fabric. Place one red fabric with one background fabric and do the same with the blue. Make HST. Press seams open and trim to 3 1/2" square. You will have 2 red and 2 blue HST.

Make an other set of HST by taking 2 of the 4" squares of the Star fabrics and 1 Red fabric and 1 blue fabric. Place one red fabric with one Star fabric and do the same with the blue. Make HST. Press seams open and trim to 3 1/2" square. You will have 2 red and Star fabric and 2 Blue and Star Fabric HST.

Layout as seen in photo.

Sew together row by row once pattern is done. Press seams open.
