

## Catch That Drip!

### AKA: Tissue Packet Cover with Wine Glass Variation

Fabric needed:

This can be made from one piece of fabric 4" x 28" long or from scraps.

Cutting List:

Three 4" x 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles

Two 4" x 4" squares

Fold two of the rectangles in half lengthwise, wrong sides together. Finger press.

Fold both squares in half, wrong sides together. Finger press.

Layer the pieces as follows:

Place the unfolded rectangle on your work surface, right side up. Place one of the folded rectangles on top of one long edge of it, lining up the raw edges.

Working counter-clockwise and lining up raw edges, place a square on the end of the folded rectangle, follow with the other rectangle, and end with the last square.

Interweave the last square end with the first rectangle side (like closing a box lid without tape). Pin everything in place.

Sew around the perimeter of the fabric stack, using a  $\frac{3}{8}$ " seam, pivoting at each corner. Trim the corners to reduce bulk, being careful not to cut through your stitches. Turn right side out. Press. Insert tissue packet.

Wine Glass Variation:

Cut all of the fabric to the same size squares, about 5 x 5. Use the same method of construction.
