

Moonlight Quilters of Sonoma County  
Hearts  
Unfinished block measures 12 1/2"

- 1 Fat quarter White or White on White
- 1 Fat quarter of hearts fabric, red or pink

Cutting instruction:

4 - 3 7/8" squares white fabric

1 - 7" square white fabric

1 - 7 1/4" square Hearts fabric

2 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Heart fabric

1 - 7" square Hearts fabric

Using the 4 - 3 7/8" white squares and the 7 1/4 heart square to make the flying geese. Follow dirction from Youtube Video:

"How to sew no waste Flying geese" by Melanie Ham

Make 2 Flying geese measuring 3 1/2" by 6 1/2". Take both of these pieces and sew together at the 3 1/2" side.

Make HST by taking 1 white 7" square and 1 heart square. Pin right sides together. Draw line from corner to corner. Sew along that line a 1/4" away from line on both side. Cut on dawn line now you have 2 HST. Trim to 6 1/2 square. Take the 2 HST and sew together with hearts side together.

Take the 2 - 3 1/2 x 6 1/2 and sew together on the 3 1/2 side.

Take all 3 section and sew together to make heart.
