

## ROUND ROBIN 2022

### SNAP POUCH

Pam Brown's version based on Petaluma TriGuild Luncheon Favor

#### MATERIALS

##### Pouch

- Outside/focus fabric 8" x 16 1/2"
- Inside lining fabric 8" x 16 1/2"
- Fusible fleece or batting. 8" x 16 1/2"

##### Contrast Fabric

- (1) 3 1/2"x16" for casing. Fold in half lengthwise, right side out. Press
- (2) 2 1/2" squares. Fold in half to make triangles. Fold in half again to make smaller triangles. Press.

#### HARDWARE

- (2) 6 3/4" pieces of metal tape measure. Cover cut ends with duct tape

#### DIRECTIONS

Layer lining fabric, wrong side up  
Center fusible fleece/batting in middle  
Outside pouch fabric, right side up  
Fuse or pin all layers together

Quilt as desired and trim to 7 1/2" x 16"

Measure and mark with a pin 3 3/4" from either end of the front of the quilted piece. Place triangles (raw edges up) so that midpoint of triangles will be at 3 3/4" mark. Pin

Pin casing (raw edge up) over triangles and sew all layers together with a 1/4" seam. Zigzag raw edge. Press casing up.

Fold in half (right sides together).

Insert metal tape measure pieces in either end of casing with numbers up and bowed sides facing pouch front

Pin side and bottom seams. Sew with 1/4" seam. Turn inside out

To open pouch, pull on triangles and pouch will snap open.

#### **\*\*Notes about Size**

The original table favor was a little smaller and made with a commercial quilted fabric so it did not need batting or lining.

I made it this size so it would fit a pack of 6" origami paper and used origami crane fabric for the pouch. Gave them to origami friends at a conference.
