A motion was made to approve the previous Board minutes as they appeared in the May Patchwords by Marilyn Lira with a second by Jeanne Nelson. Minutes were approved.

#### Reports:

##### *President's Report – Linda Lampson*

1. Linda proposed that we go back to having only one newsletter that covers July and August, which had been done in the past. It was decided that there needs to be some research on Newsletter requirements and practices with follow up discussion at a future Board meeting.

  - The Board discussed the continued use of Village Sewing Center for programs and other events and decided to investigate other venues. Pam Brown and Mary Flynn will take this on.
  - We have money in the budget to rent a place. Pam Brown will ask members to recommend locations.

*Treasurer's Report – Michelle Crosbie*

1. Michelle will send membership dues notices around August 15<sup>th</sup>
2. Budget for 2021-2022 is in progress.
3. Review of the budget to date:
  - \$5895 was collected for dues so that increased our income from our projection.
  - Not a lot of expenses this year
  - Not a lot of reimbursement requests this year.
  - Net income is currently \$397.

*Membership Report – Kathy Vedder and Miriam Marlin*

1. We have 138 members.
2. People like to pay online if it is feasible.
3. We are low on membership badge packets. Miriam is looking into how to get these and how to get the MQSC graphic. Mary Flynn and Marilyn Lira may be able to assist and will follow up with Miriam.
4. New member tea
  - Not something we feel we can do right now due to COVID
    - We would like to hold a welcome event that old members can attend as well.
    - They are working on ways to increase membership.
    - Have new members sit/partner with a senior member for meetings.
    - 1<sup>st</sup> Fridays at Village are an idea of where new members can get oriented.
  - They will continue this discussion at another Board Meeting.
5. Affiliates for next year
  - Discussed that we should ask affiliates to pay dues; this will allow them to be picked up for the quilt show in 2022.
    - The Board will work to carefully word what we send out to make it clear what their fee is covering going forward.
    - Kathy will print the email that explains the different types of membership for affiliates and will send to the Board members to review.
  - They will continue this discussion at another Board meeting.

  - Per Constitution, meetings are held in September (after instillation of officers), December, March, and June (after Quilt Show).

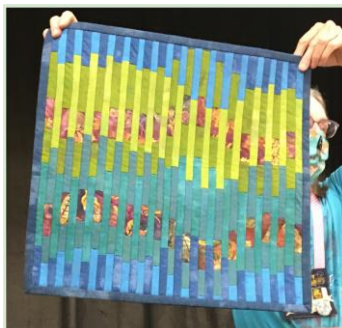
